


Volunteer Role Description

What is a Volunteer Photographer?

Our Volunteer Photographers take images of the Fulham Palace site and specific on-site events, and provide Fulham Palace Trust with photographs for a range of media and library use. They should have access to a digital SLR camera, which can produce high resolution images.

What's involved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photographing the Palace, surrounding building, gardens, and, if interested, public events, including large-scale outdoor events, workshops, talks, tours and drop-ins • Working to a brief set when required • Processing, editing, file naming and transferring selected images for Trust's use • Securing relevant model/property releases at the time of taking a photograph

Availability	Flexible, volunteering will be by prior arrangement for events and specific projects
