What is a Museum Steward?

The role of the volunteer museum steward is to welcome visitors to the Museum rooms, to provide information about the history of the Palace, the museum exhibits, assist visitors with other queries, and help with security.

Main activities

- Welcome visitors and direct them to relevant displays or other facilities in the Palace.
- Work as part of the team to ensure the highest standards of visitor care and interpretation.
- Respond to queries or refer visitor to a member of staff.
- Assist visitors who are following the family trail. Be aware that children should be accompanied by adults.
- Monitor the safety of collections in your allocated room, if you are concerned, notify a staff member.
- Maximise opportunities to engage visitors with the history of the Palace.
- Ensure that fire exits are not blocked and are only used in an emergency.
- Make visitors aware that food and drink should not be brought into the Museum.

About you/ the role will suit people who

- Friendly, approachable and confident when talking to members of the public.
- An interest in history and communicating this to visitors of all ages and backgrounds (although prior knowledge of Fulham Palace's history is not expected).
- Willing to undertake training related to the role.
- Enjoy working as part of a team.
