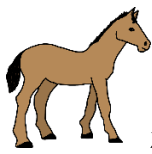


Name that plant



















means **Coltsfoot** not horse's foot!



Coltsfoot is interesting, as the stem and flower grow about 7cm away from the leaves and main root. Another interesting fact is that in the 1950s and 60s you could use coltsfoot flower to make wine (my Grandmother used to make it!).
