Our team volunteering package includes:

- Fascinating tasks working alongside our friendly and talented gardens team; offering your group an exciting insight into the horticultural activities at Fulham Palace;
- First aid trained staff on hand;
- Opportunity to explore our exhibitions and relax in the botanic garden after your day of volunteering.
- We supply gardening gloves, tools and full supervision.

Volunteers must wear clothes they don't mind getting dirty and wear sturdy footwear trainers or walking boots etc. – no open toes sandals! If it rains we can take cover until it passes or if light we might just carry on, water proof jackets are recommended though. We don't currently have a wet weather inside option but can keep an eye on the weather and plan accordingly closer to the time.

Covering our costs

We are delighted that groups generously give their time to volunteer with us, and we appreciate what a substantial gift that is in itself, but as a responsible charity we recognise that hosting volunteering days costs us too. We pay our staff to prepare for and supervise your group, ensuring that all aspects of the day are safe and that your employees are well looked after. For these reasons we charge a fee.
