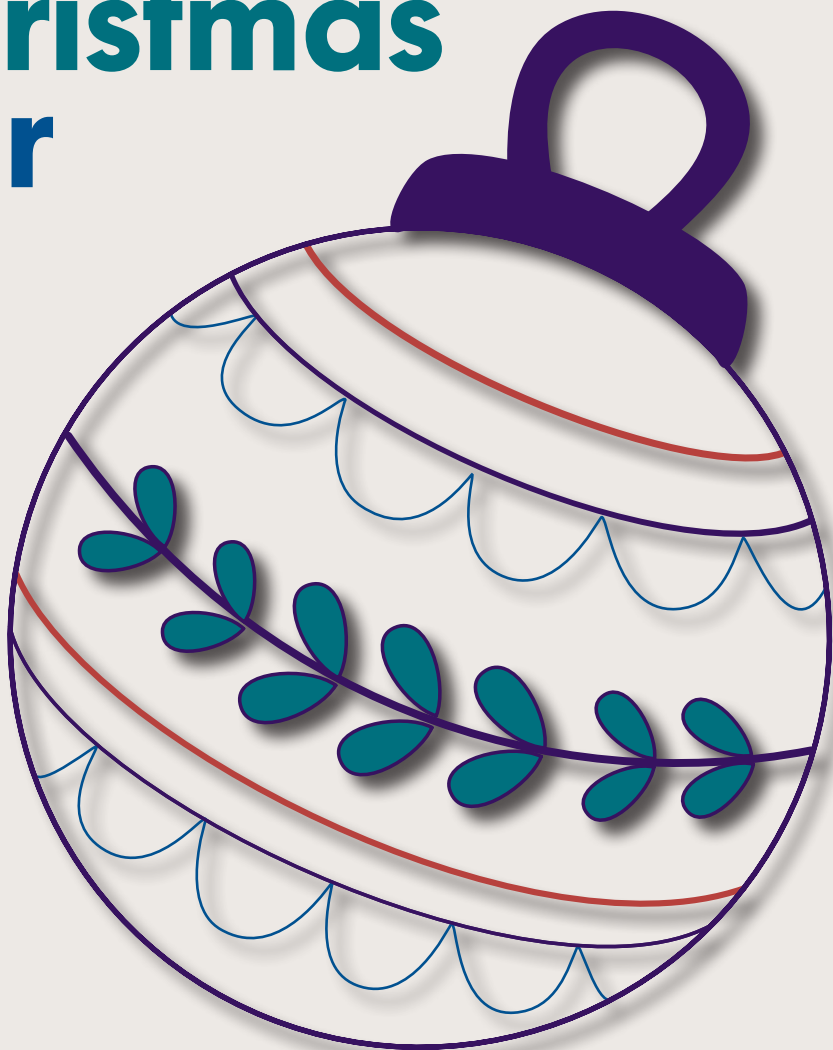

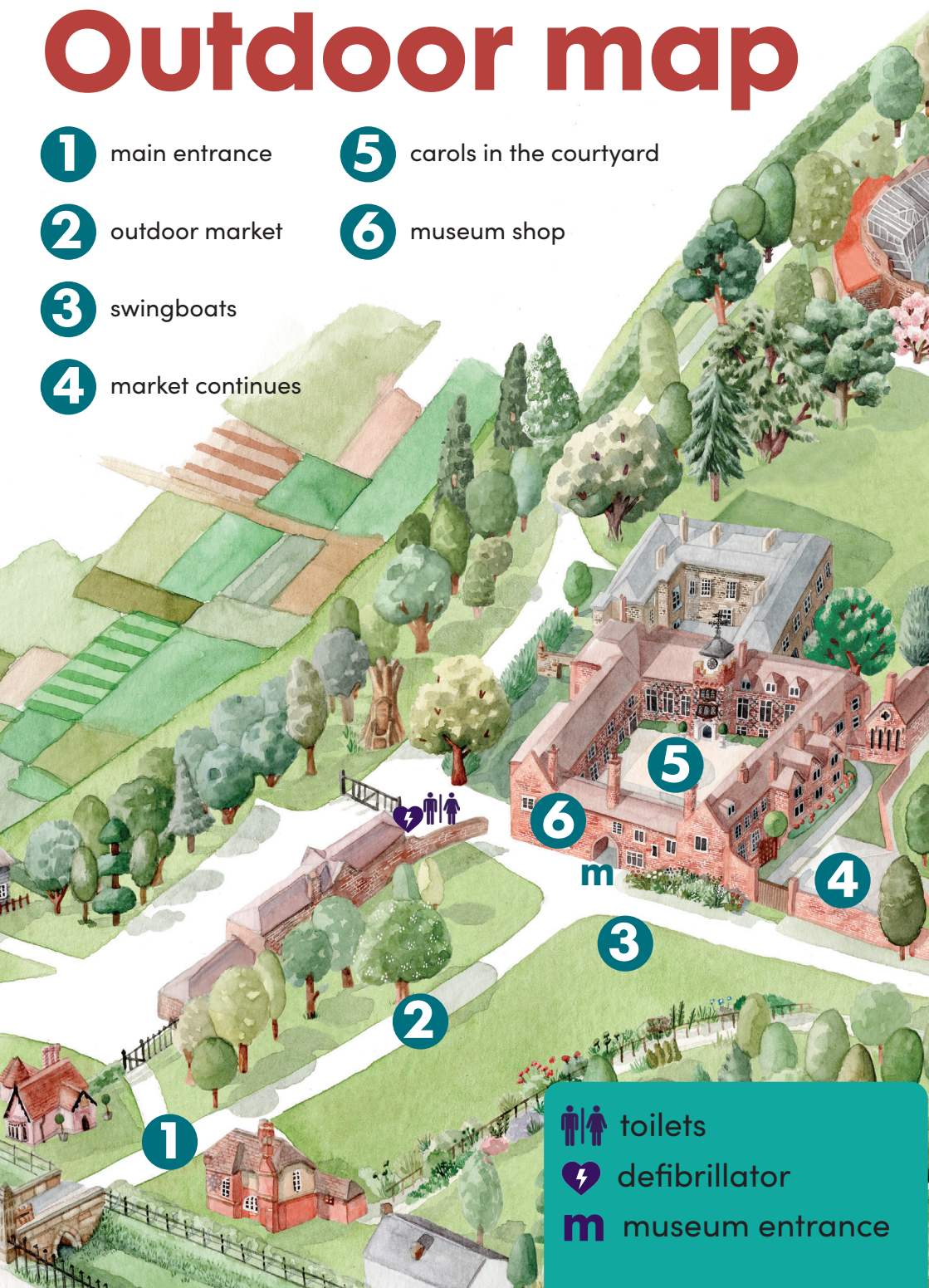

- 6** museum shop



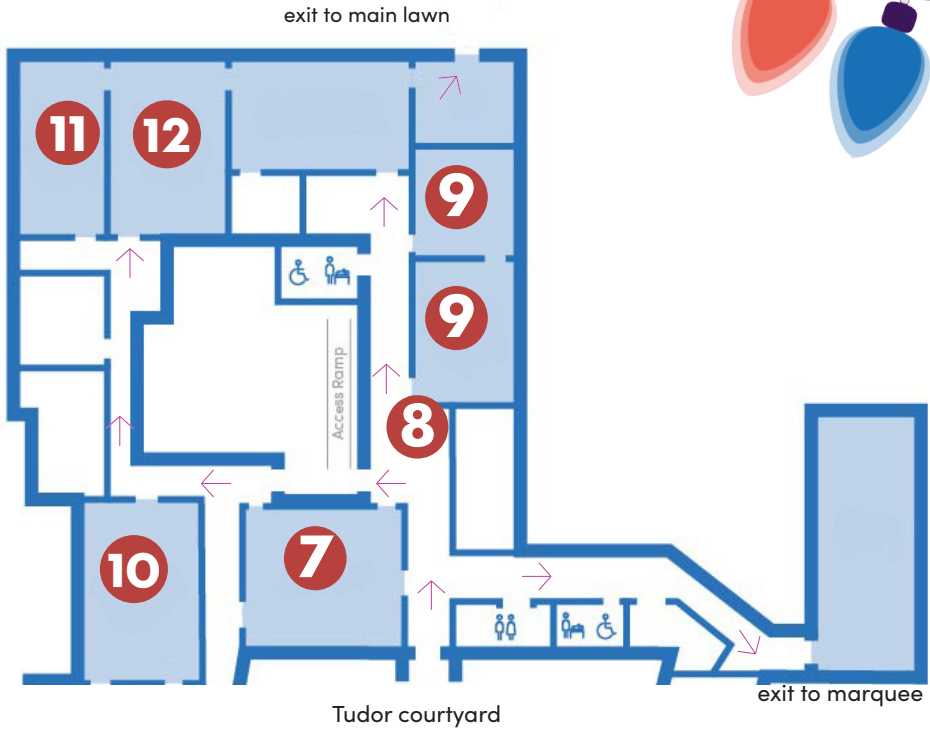
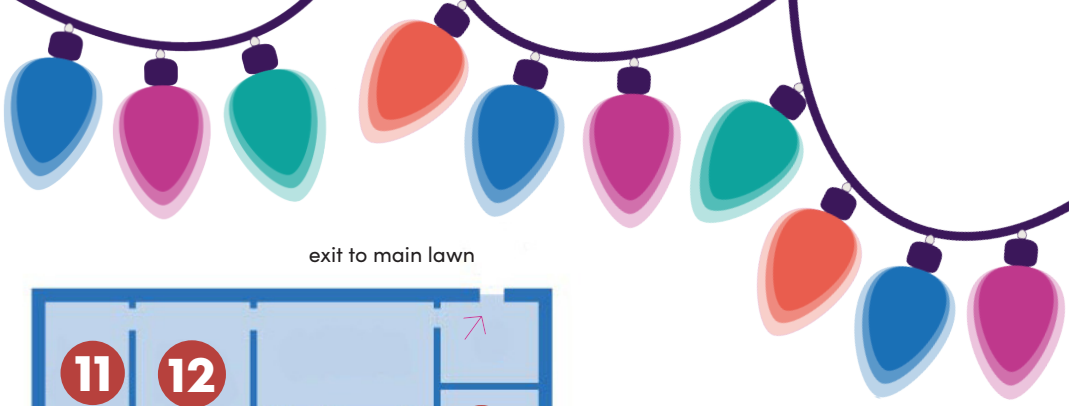
