What is a retail volunteer?

Retail volunteers play an important role in helping generate essential income for the Fulham Palace Trust, an independent charity. Based in the Fulham Palace museum gift shop, they provide a warm welcome to visitors and operate the till to assist selling a curated range of products related to the house and garden. They promote current products, assist in shop re-stocking and presentation and advise on the visitor offer.



They also help organise and run the museum shop stall during public events. Retail volunteers are part of the front of house team, who bring our spaces to life by providing a warm welcome for all visitors, promoting the charity and sharing their passion for Fulham Palace and its history.
