The historic home of the Bishop of London since 704 AD, Fulham Palace now welcomes visitors to its historic house and stunning garden all year-round, for free.

We are offering artists and exhibitors the opportunity to contribute towards the rich cultural legacy of the site. Your work will hang in rooms that have played host to some of the most impactful figures in British history; abolitionists and academics, soldiers and civilians, zealots of the church, enemies of the state and even members of the royal family.

We particularly encourage exhibitions with a link to the historic context or contemporary programming of the Palace, including our commitment to decolonisation in heritage, our connection to the natural environment and our focus on local history and communities.

Our exhibition spaces

Exhibitors have the option of displaying their work in either one or both of the historic Bishop Terrick's rooms.

These striking south-facing rooms are dappled with natural light throughout the day. Large floor to ceiling windows reveal the prospect of the Tait chapel and the historic sundial, as well as many ancient trees on the south lawn.

Each room can accommodate hanging pictures as well as smaller works within the bookshelf nooks. Our exhibition manager can discuss the layout that works best for your particular portfolio.
